Bay Escape

Athol & Mosman

Cruise through tranquil coves and leafy waterfronts, soaking in the charm of Mosman Bay's peaceful shoreline and city views.

Itinerary

1. Depart from Rose Bay
2. Anchor at Athol Bay (near Taronga Zoo) – Perfect for swimming, relaxing, and enjoying views of the Harbour Bridge and Opera House
3. Cruise around to Mosman Bay for a scenic sail past stunning waterfront homes
4. Optional short anchor stop or slow cruise near Cremorne Point for final photos and light refreshments
5. Return to departure point Rose Bay



Eastern Escape

Watsons Bay & Camp Cove

Drop anchor at Sydney's eastern edge, where clear waters and sandy shores meet relaxed coastal energy and unbeatable harbour views.

Itinerary

1. Depart from Circular Quay
2. Cruise past Sydney Opera House, Harbour Bridge, and Garden Island (to get to camp cove)
3. Anchor at Camp Cove (sheltered, great for swimming/snorkeling)
4. Cruise back past Watsons Bay and South Head for cliff views
5. Return to departure point



Hidden Harbour Gems

Store Beach Adventure

Accessible only by water, Store Beach offers a quiet, untouched escape — perfect for a private swim or picnic beneath the cliffs.

Itinerary

1. Depart from Rose Bay
2. Anchor at Athol Bay (near Taronga Zoo) – Perfect for swimming, relaxing, and enjoying views of the Harbour Bridge and Opera House
3. Cruise around to Mosman Bay for a scenic sail past stunning waterfront homes
4. Optional short anchor stop or slow cruise near Cremorne Point for final photos and light refreshments
5. Return to departure point Rose Bay



Northern Bliss

Balmoral & Chinaman's Beach

Unwind in Sydney's northern harbourside jewels, where calm waters, soft sand, and laid-back elegance create the perfect escape.

Itinerary

1. Depart from Rose Bay or Spit Bridge
2. Cruise through Middle Harbour, past exclusive waterfront homes
3. Anchor near Chinaman's Beach or Balmoral Beach (Swim, paddleboard, sunbathe, or enjoy a beach-themed lunch)
4. Optional loop past Clontarf Reserve or Sirius Cove
5. Return to departure point



Luxe Coastal Drift

Milk Beach & Hermit Bay

Enjoy a front-row view of Sydney's skyline from secluded beaches with calm waters, ideal for swimming, lounging, or light adventure.

Itinerary

1. Depart from Rose Bay Wharf
2. Cruise along the scenic Vaucluse and Point Piper shoreline, showcasing some of Sydney's most luxurious homes
3. Anchor off Milk Beach or nearby Hermit Bay (part of Shark Island National Park) [Swim, sunbathe, or enjoy onboard dining with an iconic view of the Harbour Bridge and city skyline]
4. Cruise past Shark Island and return via Double Bay
5. Return to Rose Bay



Secluded Serenity

Castle Rock & Grotto Point

Tucked-away coves and sandstone cliffs define this peaceful stretch of harbour — a quiet, scenic anchor spot away from the crowds.

Itinerary

1. Depart from Manly Wharf or Rose Bay
2. Cruise past Dobroyd Head, with views of Crater Cove huts and rugged cliffs
3. Anchor near Castle Rock Beach or Grotto Point (Swimming, snorkeling, or relaxing with scenic bushland around)
4. Cruise back via Middle Harbour, optional slow pass by Spit Bridge
5. Return to departure point
